We understand the reason for the current wording of the clause is to prevent information about the Scheme being included in irrelevant documentation. For example, the majority of Transpower's invoices are issued to persons who do not have standing to make complaints against it under the Scheme, such as generators, distributors and industrial consumers connected to the grid. It is therefore not necessary or appropriate for information about the Scheme to appear in those invoices. Appropriate limiting words should remain in clause C.26. However, Transpower agrees that the current drafting of clause C.26 could be improved. We suggest the following: C.26 Each Scheme Member must include the following information: C.26.1 advice that the Scheme Member has a free internal complaints process; and C.26.2 information about the existence, nature of, and contact details 	
		for the Scheme; and C.26.3 the way in which, and to whom in the Scheme Member's	

		organisation, complaints may be made,
